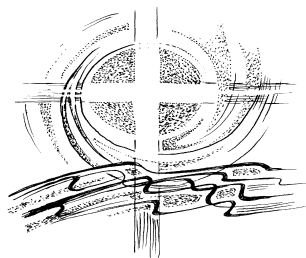

All Saints' Day 2016: This coming Tuesday, 1st November 2016 is the Solemnity of All Saints 'All Hallows' and is a Holyday of Obligation. There will be Masses across our Local Pastoral Area shown on the front of this Newsletter. The First Mass is a Vigil Mass at St Saviour's on Monday Evening 'All Hallows Eve', where the expression 'Halloween' comes from. All Saints reminds us that we are part of the 'Communion of Saints' part of a Church that is in Communion with all those who have walked the way of God before us; we think of those we call 'Saints', those who have completed their journey and are in God's presence, whose prayer we ask for us who are still on the journey. We in our turn pray for those who have died, perhaps more recently and known to us, that they may 'open out' and 'be set free' to enter fully into the presence of God, those we call 'the Holy Souls in Purgatory'. We pray that they will enter into the fullness of life and pray for us; together we form a circle of love in the Communion of God's People, 'God's Saints'. On this day we celebrate being 'God's people' that journey and support one another in our journey of this life to the fullness of life with God. All Souls Day on Saturday is a day when we pray especially for 'the Holy Souls in Purgatory'; whilst not a Holyday of Obligation like All Saints. It is a day when people like to come to Mass to pray for their loved ones.
